Sonnets 101. A sonnet is simple enough: 14 lines written in iambic pentameter. That means each line has 10 syllables in an alternating unstressed-stressed (iambic) pattern. For example, see the bold syllables in this line from John Milton: “When I consider how my light is spent” (da-DUM-da-DUM-da-DUM-da-DUM-da-DUM).
