23-2 Roots As soon as a seedling begins to grow, it sends out a primary root. Other roots branch out from the primary root. They are called secondary roots. In some plants, the primary root grows long and thick. The secondary roots stay small. This kind of primary root is called a taproot. In other plants, secondary roots grow and branch.
