What is the difference between efficacy and effectiveness ...

5-HTP can affect a brain chemical called serotonin. Dextromethorphan (Robitussin DM, others) can also affect serotonin. In pharmacology, efficacy (E max) is the maximum response achievable from an applied or dosed agent, for instance, a small molecule drug. Intrinsic activity is a relative term for a drug's efficacy relative to a drug with the highest observed efficacy. It is a purely descriptive term that has little or no mechanistic interpretation.

AET Routine Test. To evaluate the antimicrobial effectiveness of a product, the product is inoculated with a prescribed quantity of specified microorganisms. 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2.7.3 summary of clinical efficacy

The exact times for disinfecting medical items are somewhat elusive because of the effect of the aforementioned factors on disinfection efficacy. Certain contact times have proved reliable (Table 1), but, in general, longer contact times are more effective than shorter contact times.

5.1.3. EFFICACY OF ANTIMICROBIAL PRESERVATION If a pharmaceutical preparation does not itself have adequate antimicrobial activity, antimicrobial preservatives may be added, particularly to aqueous preparations, to prevent proliferation or to limit microbial contamination which, during normal

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5.1.3. Efficacy of antimicrobial preservation (EP 5.0)

The procedures are the United States Pharmacopeia (USP) <51> Antimicrobial Effectiveness Testing, the European Pharmacopeia (Ph. Eur. or EP) 5.1.3 Efficacy of Antimicrobial Preservation, and the Japanese Pharmacopeia (JP) 19, Preservative Effectiveness Tests (4-6). These compendial chapters are essentially harmonized with respect to how the test is performed; however, there are minor differences with respect to selection of challenge organisms, test intervals, and the acceptance criteria.

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
