After a scroll had cured an illness, it was retained in a trunk in case of sudden illness or physical danger. If not buried on the last night of the year, scrolls were rarely preserved beyond a few generations. The oldest surviving scroll dates to the early sixteenth century.

The five-part design of this cuff band became popular in the sixth century and is found on garments of both silk and tapestry weave. At center the bust of a woman, probably a personification, fills a roundel; she wears a colorful, ornamented tunic. To either side a vine scroll with birds and gazelles fills the double registers.
