ACEA engine oil specification What does ACEA mean? ACEA is the abbreviation for Association des Constructeurs Europeens d'Automobiles (Union of European car manufacturers). This committee has developed new classifications for the application of engine oils in gasoline, passenger cars diesel and heavy-duty diesel engines.

ACEA This is the European equivalent of API (US) and is more specific in what the performance of the oil actually is. A = Petrol, B = Diesel and C = Catalyst compatible or low SAPS (Sulphated Ash, Phosphorus and Sulphur). Unlike API the ACEA specs are split into performance/application categories as follows:
