This is a collaborative effort between the Product Owner and the Development Team—and it's focused entirely on the Product Backlog (the Development Team is solely responsible for the ordering of the Sprint Backlog).

So, if I estimate or reestimate the story in sprint planning, I CAN'T estimate it relatively to the rest of the backlog. I don't know that level of detail about the rest of the stories. I'm now thinking at a different level of detail, using a different kind of thinking than when we estimated the other stories.

III. Course: Agile Estimating And Sprint Planning

Means if your sprint is 2 weeks your Sprint Planning meeting will take 4 Hours, if its is of 3 Weeks your Sprint Planning should be 6 hours and so on. But in practical practice of each team is different. We are maturing our agile practice and improving the way we started running our agile framework.

Agile Estimating and Planning: Which method should you choose?

If the team were to answer the boss by splitting each user story into tasks, as is commonly done in sprint planning, and estimating each of those, the time spent estimating would be huge. If we assume an average of 15 minutes discussion and estimating per user story (as is commonly needed during sprint planning), estimating 40 user stories would take 600 minutes or 10 hours of whole-team effort.

Agile Estimating Planning Your Sprint

Definition. Sprint planning is an event in the Scrum framework where the team determines the product backlog items they will work on during that sprint and discusses their initial plan for completing those product backlog items.. Teams may find it helpful to establish a sprint goal and use that as the basis by which they determine which product backlog items they work on during that sprint.

Tips for effective sprint planning & estimation in agile scrum

So, Sprint Planning you decide what the goal of the sprint is, determine which Product Backlog Items will be included in the sprint, break the PBIs down into sub tasks and you possibly might estimate the sub tasks. But this is really important, you ideally don't want your sub tasks to be bigger than a day's work.
