All Else Equal, however, examines 15 years of studies and finds that there is no difference in achievement between students at public and private schools. 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All else equal : are public and private schools different ...

Luis Benveniste, Martin Carnoy and Richard Rothstein conducted a case study of 16 schools -eight public and eight private - to determine which elements are most important to school effectiveness. They found no significant difference between the learning outcomes produced by private vs. public schools.
