APA format details a set of clear rules for referencing articles that appear in academic journals and other periodicals. Article references will vary somewhat based on where the article appears and who authored the content. While many articles you will use in your references probably appear in academic and professional journals, you might also find articles in magazines, newspapers, and online publications.

### How do I mention an article within an APA paper? Is it in ...

The American Psychological Association (APA) has specific guidelines on how to include an article title in the text of your writing. Consider section 4.21 of the APA Publication Manual "Use of Italics;" according to it, italics should be used for titles of books, periodicals, films, videos, television shows, and microfilm.

### How to Reference Journal Articles in APA Format

In APA style journal citations, journal titles are written in title case and followed by the volume number. Both of these fields should be italicized. Citing a journal article found online (in a database or elsewhere) Structure: Author, F.M. (Publication year). Article Title.

### **Reference List: Electronic Sources // Purdue Writing Lab**

**A basic reference list entry for a journal article in APA must include: Author or authors. The surname is followed by first initials. Year of publication of the article (in round brackets). Article title. Journal title (in italics). Volume of journal (in italics). Issue number of journal in round brackets (no italics). Page range of article. DOI.**

### **APA Journal Citation | APA Format**

**APA style does not require Database information in its citations. You would cite the source found within the Database, such as a journal article or a photograph.**

Here is an APA citation for the article from the Journal of Interactive Online Learning —the journal whose homepage we found. Because the article does not have a DOI, the APA citation ends with "Retrieved from" followed by the URL of the journal homepage:**

### **Apa Format For Journal Articles**

**APA style dictates that authors are named last name followed by initials; publication year goes between parentheses, followed by a period. The title of the article is in sentence-case, meaning only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized.**
