Ushers should be focused only on their duties when they are serving. They should not be listening to music, taking phone calls, chewing gum or ignoring someone who needs help to talk to someone else. If an usher has a specific duty, such as barring entrance to the sanctuary when a prayer is in progress, she should strive to perform her duty in a polite manner that will not offend anyone.

Guidelines for Church Ushers - Sword of the Lord Ministries

An usher signals prayer by crossing his right arm over his left, with each hand touching the opposite elbow. When it is time for the ushers to assume their stations, the lead usher moves his right hand in an arc from his left cheek to his right hip, which is also the signal for asking how many chairs are available in a row.

Generally, the ministry of church ushers focuses on the following areas of responsibilities (if they occur in your church): Assist in the seating members and visitors; Provide care for the needs of the pastor during the service. Attend to the needs of the visiting speaker or guests of honor.
