James Chapter 4 Verses 1-3: In chapter 3, the scripture ended by stressing the peace that results from heavenly wisdom. Now James emphasizes the strife so common among his readers, stemming from their unsatisfied, selfish desires.

Next, read James 4:7-10 to find out how to be humble. Ask, "What can we do to increase our humility (submit to God, resist the devil, come near to God, repent, grieve over our sins, etc)?" \* Emphasize that first submitting to God is necessary if we want to become strong and humble Christ-followers, and then we must actively resist temptation.
