The one for brake bleeding was good because there is a slight difference for bleeding the front discs versus the rear drums. I left my key to the ON position when doing this and the fluid just pours out the back drums. For the fronts, it is more important to pump up the pressure first then crack the bleeder and the fluid shoots out.
