Theravada Buddhism, found in Sri Lanka, Burma, Thailand, Laos, and Cambodia, accepts only the writings of the Pali canon as authoritative, emphasizes the Four Noble Truths in attaining nirvana, and generally avoids metaphysical speculation. Each person is said to be responsible for attaining his or her own enlightenment ('self-effort'), which is restricted to the few who can master the required disciplines.
