CDC Statement on Reprocessing Dental Handpieces ...

Reprocessing can be performed at the point of care (POC) or in a separate room. If conducted at POC, the products used must be safe to use in that setting. If reprocessing is performed in another room, a system for transducer transport must be implemented to ensure that dirty and clean transducers are not mixed.
