Monk's House is an 16th-century weatherboarded cottage in the village of Rodmell, three miles (4.8km) south of Lewes, East Sussex, England.The writer Virginia Woolf and her husband, the political activist, journalist and editor Leonard Woolf, bought the house by auction at the White Hart Hotel, Lewes, on 1 July 1919 for 700 pounds, and received there many visitors connected to the Bloomsbury ...

Berwick Church, Charleston Farmhouse and Monks House

Monk's House was the country home of the novelist Virginia Woolf. The tranquil 17th-century farmhouse is located 7 miles away from Charleston in the village of Rodmell. Berwick Church is the home of extensive murals by Bloomsbury group artists, including former Charleston residents Vanessa Bell and Duncan Grant.

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
