Although Chaucer never refers to it directly, he likely got much of his source material from Boccaccio ' s Decameron, a series of linked stories that have a similar structure to The Canterbury Tales: just as the Tales are told by pilgrims on their way to Canterbury, the stories of the Decameron are told by lords and ladies traveling around Florence as they try to avoid the Black Plague.
