Abuse of a child or young person under the age of 18 is defined as follows. Abuse is a deliberate act of ill-treatment that can harm or is likely to harm a child or young person's safety, well-being and development.

Safeguarding Children Definition & Explaining Child Protection

Child protection is, therefore, more specific than child safeguarding. Child safeguarding refers to everything and anything that can be done to protect all children and young people from harm. Child protection refers to protection put in place by specific agencies in specific cases where it has been identified that a child or young person requires a raised level of support and monitoring.
