Cisco Unified Personal Communicator Administration on IM ...
If Cisco Unified Personal Communicator user has more than one associated softphone device in Cisco Unified Communications Manager, you can specify which device to use on startup by excluding all other devices. To do this, you must set the value of the following registry key value to be a comma-separated list of device names, as follows:

Adjunct Licensing/Adjunct Device. With adjunct licensing, fewer device license units (DLUs) get consumed for adjunct (secondary) devices, such as Cisco IP Communicator, Cisco Unified Personal Communicator, and Cisco Unified Mobile Communicator, when these applications get used with a Cisco Unified IP Phone, which serves as the primary device.

Cisco Unified Personal Communicator Administration on IM ...
Cisco Unified Personal Communicator attempts to reconnect to the next available CTI server. Until a connection is established, the Cisco Unified Personal Communicator user cannot initiate any new calls through the application. No new incoming call notifications are provided through the application.
