Whereas the history is the most important element in defining the clinical problem, neurologic examination is performed to localize a lesion in the central nervous system (CNS) or peripheral nervous system (PNS).

A neurological examination is the assessment of sensory neuron and motor responses, especially reflexes, to determine whether the nervous system is impaired. This typically includes a physical examination and a review of the patient's medical history, but not deeper investigation such as neuroimaging.

Clinical examination of the Cranial Nerves
The decision as when to do the examination is made during the first few minutes of taking the history, which, in effect, is the first part of the mental status examination. Defer the mental status examination until later in a patient who comes across as normal during the initial minutes of the interview.
