The clinical manifestations of protein deficiency include hair loss, peripheral edema, poor wound healing, and loss of lean body mass . The protein intake requirement after surgery is 60–80 g/d or 1.1–1.5 g/kg of ideal body weight (i.e., BMI = 25) and increases to 90–120 g/d after BPD/BPD-DS (5, 44, 57, 58, 60, 62, 63).
