A second category of context clues is synonyms. A synonym is a word that shares a near meaning with another word. For example, "loud" and "noisy" mean similar things but are two different words. Take a look at the following sentence to see how synonyms can be good context clues: The patient's hippocampus was an uncharted minefield.
