An Inference is a conclusion we come to by analyzing Information. It is inductive reasoning: looking at facts and then making a conclusion from those facts. An Interpretation is an Inference from a specific Point of View. Two people might have the same facts, but with different Points of View, they may each come to a different solution to the problem.

### Critical Thinking Interpreting Observations Answers

The most well known use of observation and interpretation, as well as the other steps in critical thinking, is in the scientific method. In order to answer a specific scientific question, researchers must first make observations by asking the questions to the left and conducting research based on those answers.

To calculate a NEWS you need to record six physiological parameters (respiratory rate, oxygen saturation levels, blood pressure, temperature, pulse rate, and level of consciousness) on the patient's observation chart and refer to the scoring chart to work out how the patient should be managed (box 1).
