Why Cultural Appropriation Is Wrong

The campaigns against cultural appropriation are an implicit acceptance that the playing field cannot be levelled, and that the best we can do is fence off certain areas. A key argument of those who abhor cultural appropriation is that if one does

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make use of ideas or images or objects from other cultures, one should do so only with 'respect'.
