The speaker looks back to the time of the flax-dam - flax or linseed is a plant grown for its seed and oil - painting a picture in alliterative and assonantal words, typical of Heaney.. The flax-dam festered, that is, decayed, as the sods (lumps of turf or grass) weighed them down on a piece of land in the town.
