Working at near film resolution, the digital intermediate process enables filmmakers to manipulate the color, mood, lighting and virtually any other attribute of their imagery with unprecedented precision to tell ...

Digital Intermediate also does both these processes, but works at a much higher resolution - at least '2k'. Let's assume the resolution of film is 2k. In a conventional telecine process, one frame on 35 mm film which is 2048x1556 pixels is converted to 720x576 pixels (about 1/8th the size) and put on to a tape.

What happens with modern digital intermediate (which is quite different than it was even 10 years ago), is that a film will shoot in a very high-quality format. Often RAW or the like. These formats capture tons of data, but, once in post, not all of the data is needed. For example, it would capture a huge dynamic range of light.
