By contrast, indirect characterization shows what the character does and lets the audience infer characterization. In works of fiction, authors employ a wide variety of strategies to create and present characters to audiences. In general, authors use some combination of both direct and indirect characterization to describe characters.

Direct characterization and indirect characterization ...

Characterization includes both descriptions of a character’s physical attributes as well as the character’s personality. The way that characters act, think, and speak also adds to their characterization. There are two subsets of the definition of characterization: direct and indirect characterization.

Seventh grade Lesson Direct and Indirect Characterization

Indirect characterization is the opposite of direct characterization. Instead of coming out and telling you what to think about the character, the author describes the person’s appearance, actions and words, and sometimes even thoughts to help the reader form an opinion about the character. OSCAR | Direct and Indirect Characterization

Direct Characterization is pretty straightforward. If I were to say, “John is a mean person with a snobby attitude” I would be using direct characterization. I’m TELLING you exactly what John is like. Indirect characterization would be SHOWING you how John is mean instead of just telling you.

EXAMPLE ANSWER "I watched Aaron as his face turned white, and his hands began to shake as they hovered over the phone." Indirect characterization: The reader assumes that Aaron is upset because his face turned white, and his hands were shaking. When the reader assumes or infers information based on what they read, it is indirect characterization.

3. Use indirect characterization to show consequences. One way of thinking of direct characterization vs indirect characterization is to think of cause and effect. For example, the direct characterization of Mother’s Younger Brother in Ragtime (he is 'lonely') leads to the longer arc of his actions (stalking a famous chorus girl).

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
