When the Divine Liturgy of Saint Basil is celebrated in the evening, it is combined with Vespers to form a Vigil Divine Liturgy. The Divine Liturgy of Saint Basil, as celebrated today, is very similar to the Divine Liturgy of Saint John Chrysostom, differing primarily in the priest's prayers, and in the use of a different hymn to the Mother of God and Ever-Virgin Mary at the end of the anaphora.

Divine Liturgy: Liturgy of the Sacrifice

The Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom is one of the key Eucharistic liturgies of the Orthodox Church; it is used on most weekdays and dates back, I believe, to the fifth century. The Divine Liturgies of St. Basil and St. John Chrysostom are said to derive from the former, which was the ancient Rite of Jerusalem, the see of St. James the Just, with influence from the ancient Anaphora of the Twelve Apostles historically used in Antioch, whereas the latter is the ancient rite of Alexandria, the See of the Apostle Mark.

As a divine liturgy of the Church of Holy Wisdom, Hagia Sophia, it became over time the usual divine liturgy in the churches within the Byzantine Empire. Just two divine liturgies (aside from the presanctified), those of Saints John and Basil the Great , became the norm in the Byzantine Church by the end of the reign of Justinian I . [1]

The liturgy achieved a basic framework by the ninth century. There are three forms of the Eucharist presently in use in the Orthodox Church: The Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom, which is the most frequently celebrated. The Liturgy of St. Basil the Great, which is celebrated only ten times a year.
