Through inspection of food facilities, the Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS) can reinforce food safety principles. During an inspection, an Official Notice of Violation (NOV) is issued when the REHS determines the facility is not in compliance with the law.

Environmental Health Food Law Enforcement

Colorado is incorporating the 2013 FDA Food Code by reference as the revised Colorado Retail Food Establishment Rules and Regulations which is effective as of January 1, 2019. Changes to the enforcement process will also take effect January 1, 2020.
