Child Trafficking - UNICEF USA

Child victims of trafficking are recruited, transported, transferred, harbored or received for the purpose of exploitation. They may be forced to work in sweatshops, on construction sites or in houses as domestic servants; on the streets as child beggars, in wars as child soldiers, on farms, in traveling sales crews or in restaurants and hotels.

Trafficked children are subjected to prostitution, forced into marriage or illegally adopted; they provide cheap or unpaid labour, work as house servants or beggars, are recruited into armed groups

These children can be at a high risk of child trafficking when they are taken to another location for sexual exploitation, such as for the production of pornography (in such cases, it can be considered as child trafficking since it involves the movement of the child for the purpose of exploitation).

about 160 people were convicted of child abduction and child trafficking. The majority of them were involved particularly in trafficking of children for sexual exploitation.⁴ Who gets trafficked? Malaysian children and women are trafficked to Singapore, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Japan,⁵ Canada, USA, Europe and Australia⁶ for prostitution.

The NAPITIP/UNICEF Situation Assessment of Child Trafficking in Southern Nigerian State (2004) reported that 46% of repatriated victims of external trafficking in Nigeria are children, with a female to male ratio of 7:3. They are engaged mainly in prostitution (46%), domestic labour (21%), forced labour (15%) and entertainment (8%). Internal

Putting Children First in Colorado | UNICEF USA

Human trafficking is a serious federal crime with penalties of up to imprisonment for life. In short, human trafficking is a form of modern slavery. Those who recruit minors into commercial sexual exploitation (or prostitution) violate federal anti-trafficking laws, even if there is no force, fraud, or coercion.
