Dujarie was born in France on December 9, 1767. He was secretly ordained as a priest in Paris on December 26, 1795 during the height of the Revolution, celebrating his first Mass in the middle of the night in a barn outside of Ruille-sur-Loir. He would celebrate many Masses this way, forced by the Revolution to become an "underground priest."
