A fiber is the smallest unit of a textile material that has a length many times greater than its diameter. Fibers can occur naturally as plant and animal fibers, but they can also be man-made. A fiber can be spun with other fibers to form a yarn that can be woven or knitted to form a fabric.

Fibers. Forensic fiber examination includes both physical match of fabric or cordage based on damaged or cut edges and individual fiber comparisons. The latter examination consists of determining whether the questioned fiber has the same chemical, microscopic and optical properties as a known sample.
