| Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration  
All CMV drivers who operate in interstate commerce are required to have a medical certificate based on FMCSA requirements. If they operate a motor vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR), gross combination weight rating (GCWR), gross vehicle weight (GCW), or gross combination weight (GCW) of 10,001 pounds or more.
