Wear barefoot, in socks or slippers. Slide your foot into the device with your mid-arch positioned near the metatarsal strap and your toe positioned to fit into the toe strap. The Bunion Aid Splint is securely fastened to the foot by means of the metatarsal strap. Secure the main strap to your foot using the hook and loop fastener.

Bunion surgery may be done on an outpatient basis or rarely as part of your stay in a hospital. Procedures may vary depending on your condition and your healthcare provider's practices. Most bunion surgery is performed under ankle block anesthesia, in which your foot is numb, but you are awake. Occasionally, general or spinal anesthesia is used.

A bunion is most likely to develop when susceptible feet are repeatedly squeezed into narrow, pointed-toe footwear. The big toe pushes against the other toes, sometimes diving over or under them. As a result, the base of the big toe — the metatarsophalangeal (MTP) joint — juts or angles out from the foot.
