Upward Communication Downward Communication; Meaning: Upward communication is the line of communication through which subordinates can convey information, to their seniors. Downward communication is the formal chain of command established to direct subordinates and convey information, pertaining to organization's objectives, policies and strategies.

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As the term suggests, downward communication flows from higher organizational levels (supervisors) to lower organizational levels (subordinates). Upward communication flows from lower to higher organizational levels. Lateral (or horizontal) communication flows across the organization, among personnel on the same level.

Formal Communication. A formal channel of communication is usually controlled by managers or people who lie in the top hierarchy in an organization. It is an official channel that is deliberately structured to form a communication chain in and organization to achieve organization goals.

Downward Communication. Downward communication occurs when information and messages flow down through an organization's formal chain of command or hierarchical structure. In other words, messages and orders start at the upper levels of the organizational hierarchy and move down toward the bottom levels.

Downward or Top-down: The communication in which the flow of information goes from superior to subordinate.

Within the framework of the organizational structure, the formal channels of communication include downward, upward, horizontal and matrix communication (marked with yellow lines on the chart).
