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Free Fractured Fairy Tales Lesson

Standard: Students will compare and contrast the fractured tales to the originals. Before Reading. In order for students to fully appreciate the fractured nature of these fairy tales, they must be familiar with the originals. Hold a class discussion about fairy tales. Ask students to name fairy tales with which they are familiar; record the titles.
