French Future Tense – going to In French, there is a different way of saying I am going to do something If you wish to say you are going to do something, you just use the conjugated form of the French verb aller (to go) with the infinitive of the intended verb

Group 1 Regular French Verbs ending in "ER" (Future Tense)

The future stem for -er and -ir verbs is the infinitive. For regular -re verbs, the stem is the infinitive minus the final e. In all cases, the future stem ends in -r: this sound characterizes the future and the conditional.The French simple future tense is generally translated into English with the modal auxiliary 'will.'

The simple future - Je travaillerai demain. - " The verbs from all groups have the same 6 endings in common : ai, as, a, ons, ez, ont " The verbs of the 1st and 2 nd groups generally keep their infinitive form but those from the 3 rd group are most of the time irregular (vouloir = je voudrai).

Simple future-French

The simple future tense (le futur simple) is the basic form of the future, and the English equivalent of "will + verb." Here's an example of how the simple future tense is used: Ils mangeront dans l'avion. (They will eat on the plane.) Note that in French, there is no translation for the often-used "will" in English.

To describe a future event that is certain to happen, and is almost imminent, French uses the futur proche (immediate future).For example: Il est 6h30, elle va préparer le dîner. (It's 6:30; she's going to prepare dinner.The future is probably the easiest tense to conjugate because its stem is the infinitive.
