Guided Reading Level. Developed by Irene Fountas and Gay Su Pinnell, the guided reading level system gives a more precise reading level for books. This detailed, alphabetic system has several levels within each grade level. For example, grade 2 is equivalent to guided reading levels J through M.

**Guided Reading Activities**  
Every classroom and every group of students are unique, but there are some universal standards for making guided reading work in any classroom community. Here are the basic guidelines: Teacher works with small groups, ideally 3-6 students. Students are grouped according to their current reading level and are working on most of the same skills.

Guided reading is one component of the shared reading block during which the teacher provides support for small, flexible groups of beginning readers. The teacher helps students learn to use reading strategies, such as context clues, letter and sound knowledge, and syntax or word structure, as they read a text or book that is unfamiliar to them.
