To combat decision fatigue, AND to help you accelerate all of your readers', I propose a small group, guided reading structure that has served me well for nearly 20 years. I'll then describe how one teacher might use this structure to plan lessons for 2 different groups.

Modified Guided Reading for ELLs - Minds in Bloom

Guided reading has always been one of my favorite parts of the day. It's a time for me to work with small groups of students to help them become stronger, more confident readers. I meet with at least 2 groups a day for 15-20 minutes (groups are flexible and based on skill/reading level).
