The 10 Basic Types of Clouds and How to Recognize Them

High Clouds. Type 1 (cirrus in the form of filaments, strands, or hooks): Cirrus clouds form very high in the atmosphere, usually between 15,000 and 30,000 feet above ground, and occur year-round in the Keys. Type 1 cirrus are very thin and wispy, and are usually in the shape of strands and hooks, or looking like feathers or horse tails.

Top 10 Highest and Lowest Layers of Clouds

Cumulonimbus clouds are one of the few clouds that span the low, middle, and high layers. They resemble the cumulus clouds from which they grow, except they rise into towers with bulging upper portions that look like cauliflower. Cumulonimbus cloud tops are usually always flattened in the shape of an anvil or plume.
