You can include the author's last name and date in parentheses at the end of the sentence containing the information you borrowed.

For a source with three or more authors, you should place the authors ' names in the same order as the source.

In-text citations for print sources with known author For print sources like books, magazines, scholarly journal articles, and newspapers, provide a signal word or phrase (usually the author ' s last name) and a page number. If you provide the signal word/phrase in the sentence, you do not need to include it in the parenthetical citation.

First, you have to think about how you want to identify your sources. If your sources are very important to your ideas, you should mention the author and work in a sentence that introduces your citation. If, however, you are only citing the source to make a minor point, you may consider using parenthetical references, footnotes, or endnotes.

Provide enough information about each source so that your audience could, with a little effort, find them. This should include the author(s) name, a brief explanation of their credentials, the title of the work, and publication date.

For sources that are freely available, include the words " Retrieved from " in front of the URL. If the source you ' re citing has to be purchased or subscribed to, include the words " Available from " before the complete URL. If a source includes a DOI (Digital Object Identifier), you need to include it at the end of your reference. Certain formats such as forum posts require adding the post or the message number as well.
