No matter where the loose seam is or what caused it, the repair procedure is the same: Dip a small artist's brush into wallpaper-seam adhesive (about \$3 for a 4-oz. tube at paint and wallcovering stores). Spread an even coat of adhesive onto the underside of the exposed seam (photo 1). Then use a wooden seam roller to flatten the seam (photo 2).

Place the pointed nozzle of the seam adhesive under the loose edge, seam, or tear and squeeze enough adhesive to coat the torn area. Don't apply so much that it get drippy. Let the adhesive dry for 15 minutes. Some new products dry solid within a few minutes, so be sure to follow the manufacturer's directions.

6) Apply tape to the seam as shown, starting at either end of the loose area. Don't start in the middle of the loose seam... you might cause a "ripple" or wrinkle. Properly applied, the tape will hold the seam together and take the curling pressure off the sealer, allowing it to hold the wallpaper in place.

Most manufacturers recommend using a butting seam for wallpaper on flat wall surfaces. To create a precise seam, position strips so the edges meet without overlapping. Don't get frustrated if you...

How to Fix Wallpaper Seams. Begin at the top of the seam and place a piece of painter's tape directly on top of the seam. Allow the tape to stay in place for 24 hours and carefully remove it. The tape will allow the sealant to dry without the pressure of the wallpaper pulling it away from the wall.

Wallpaper Seam Repair

Covering Seams. If you are going for a smooth wall look, you'll need to "float" the wallpaper seams. This means applying drywall joint compound over every seam and sanding it smooth. Apply at least two coats of joint compound, allowing it to dry for four to eight hours in between coats.

Small Repairs. Apply a wallpaper seam adhesive by squeezing the tube until a thin stream comes out of the nozzle. Squeeze out a small amount to tack down loose seams. Don't apply the adhesive to the point that it is drippy or oozing out, because any that remains on the wallpaper's surface will have a glossy appearance once it dries.

Thin Professional Vinyl over Vinyl (VOV) wallpaper adhesive, with water, to a creamy consistency. Work it into the seams by brushing back and forth across the seams with a paint brush. Alternately, you could use border adhesive or other brand of "over vinyl" wallpaper adhesive.

Wallpaper Repairs. Seams that have lifted also can be re-glued. Wallcovering stores sell mending kits that include contact cement and wood rollers to press the repair back down. To reglue loose edges, moisten the area and lift the wallpaper away from the wall. Apply a thin layer of adhesive to the back of the loose paper, press it back into place,...
