An important step in the development of schema theory was taken by the work of D.E. Rumelhart describing the understanding of narrative. Further work on the concept of schemata was conducted by W.F. We can apply the term schema in three specific ways. First, a schema is a prototype—an idealized version of a common pattern. Second, a schema can be an exemplar—a single pattern that resembles the prototype.

Schema theory was immediately applied to understanding the reading process, where it served as an important counterweight to purely bottom-up approaches to reading. The schema-theory approaches to reading emphasize that reading involves both the bottom-up information from the letters coming into the eye and the use of top-down knowledge to construct a meaningful representation of the text.
