iPod shuffle (3rd generation Late 2009) includes a three-position switch that toggles between off, play in order, and shuffle, similar to the original iPod shuffle. This model has a headphone port that also connects to a computer's USB port.

How to force restart your iPod shuffle. If your iPod shuffle doesn't respond when you press the buttons, you can force restart your device. Force restart your iPod shuffle. Unplug your iPod shuffle from its charger and from your computer. Use the power switch to turn off your iPod shuffle. If you see green by the switch, your device is on.

iPod shuffle if the status light isn't blinking orange, or if you see the "OK to disconnect" message at the top of the iTunes window. Important: If you see the "Do not disconnect" message in iTunes or if the status light on iPod shuffle is blinking orange, you must first eject iPod shuffle before disconnecting it.
