What is Intersectionality? 'Intersectionality' is a holistic approach to discrimination prevention. Kimberlé Crenshaw, Professor of Law at Harvard University, designed it as a framework and analytical tool. Crenshaw was struck by the way that different types of 'identity' (such as race, gender, and sexual orientation) overlap for some people.

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
