What services does UK Local Government provide compared to UK central government? In the UK Local authorities are required by law to provide some 1200 services. These range from maintaining graveyards, to ensuring that asbestos is disposed of safely, to giving grants to disabled people to adapt their homes, to agreeing licences for pubs and clubs.

Local COVID alert levels: what you need to know - GOV.UK

Councils across the UK are funded by a combination of central government grants and local tax. The balance between these funding sources varies. In England, in 2018/19 [2] , 50% of funding came from central government grants, 31% from council tax, 18% from business rates revenue (which is collected locally but then redistributed via a nationally-run system), and 1% from council reserves.
