Their caps look like the caps of the gilled mushrooms (a group that decided to hang seeds from sheets of cardboard, instead)—but, on the underside of the cap, there are tubes instead of gills. The tubes are so tightly packed that, from below, one sees only a pore surface composed of the openings of the tubes, looking rather like the surface of a sponge.

Here are a bunch of "mushroom features" to give you a sense of the kind of details to look for. Like many species of Amanita, Amanita flavoconia has warts (yellow ones, in this particular species) all over its cap. Warts are remnants of a universal veil that enclosed the entire mushroom when it was immature. Universal veils are found in all Amanita mushrooms, and a number of others as well.

#5 Meadow Mushroom or Field Mushroom (*Agaricus campestris*) Range: This species is found across North America, Europe, Asia, northern Africa, and New Zealand. It's generally found in grassland and may grow alone or in a "fairy ring." Harvest Season: Spring, summer, or fall after rain. Identifying Characteristics: The meadow mushroom has a white cap that's 5 to 10 centimeters across.
