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“MIChild” and there are some requirements that your children will have to meet to be covered. If you have children under age 19, you may be able to get health and dental care for them through MIChild if they meet the following: To start

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with the child must be under the age of 19.

you have children
under the age of 1,
your income must
be above 185
percent and equal

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to or below 200 percent of the federal poverty guideline amounts. For example, if you are a single parent of one child under the age of 1, your annual income must be between \$27, 213.50 ($\$14,710 \times 185$ percent) and \$29,420 ($\$14,710 \times$

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200 percent) to qualify for MIChild benefits.
