Formula is an expression that calculates values in a cell or in a range of cells. For example, =A2+A2+A3+A4 is a formula that adds up the values in cells A2 through A4. Function is a predefined formula already available in Excel.

A simple way to access Excel ' s power is to put your data in a table. That lets you quickly filter or sort your data. Select your data by clicking the first cell and dragging to the last cell in your data. To use the keyboard, hold down Shift while you press the arrow keys to select your data.

Each Excel workbook can contain multiple worksheets. 4 Format Cells: When we format cells in Excel, we change the appearance of a number without changing the number itself.

In Excel, the calculation can be specified using either a formula or a function. Formulas are self-defined instructions for performing calculations. In contrast, functions are pre-defined formulas that come with Excel. In either case, all formulas and functions are entered in a cell and must begin with an equal sign ' = ' .

Excel Basic Formulas and Functions

Enter a Formula. To enter a formula, execute the following steps. 1. Select a cell. 2. To let Excel know that you want to enter a formula, type an equal sign (=). 3. For example, type the formula A1+A2. Tip: instead of typing A1 and A2, simply select cell A1 and cell A2.
