Use the Resource Leveling dialog box to set preferences for the way you want resources to be leveled. Also use this dialog box to start the leveling process. Microsoft Project levels overallocated resources by delaying and splitting tasks, based on criteria you set in this dialog box.

When it does find an instance where the demand is greater than availability, it will attempt to correct the over-allocation primarily by changing the schedule to move tasks to a date when there is available resource capacity.
