Narcissism is known to be related to romantic success in short-term contexts (dating, early-stage relationships) but also to problems in long-term committed relationships.

The Two Faces of Narcissism in Romantic Relationships ...

Two studies examined narcissism and commitment in ongoing romantic relationships. In Study 1, narcissism was found to be negatively related to commitment. Mediation analyses further revealed that this was primarily a result of narcissists' perception of alternatives to their current relationship.
