*North Carolina does not list medication aides by reciprocity, endorsement, or transfer from other states. To be listed on the N.C. Medication Aide Registry for Adult Care Homes, an out-of-state medication aide must pass the N.C state medication aide written exam, approved medication aide training program, and complete the clinical skills requirement.*
